

He is the founder of the Queer Roma media project called "QRTV Europa". In 2016 he was nominated for the Prize of Hungarian Roma Press Center called "Aranypánt-díj" which awards young successful Hungarian Roma people. He was awarded with a Certificate of Appreciation by the Hungarian Talent Encouragement Program named by Dr. Jozsef Varga, as an "Exemplary career starter".

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
