

NATAŠA TASIĆ KNEŽEVIĆ

Nataša Tasić Knežević is the soloist of the Opera of the Serbian National Theater. She was born in Belgrade. She sang for years in the church of St. George as a soloist, and then as a scholarship holder of Princess Jelisaveta Karađorđević, she enrolled in the Academy of Fine Arts, solo singing department. She is finishing her specialist studies at the Faculty of Music Arts in Belgrade in the class of Professor Višnja Pavlović. During her studies, she was a scholarship holder of the SOROS Foundation and in 2012 She was declared one of the most prominent Roma women in the world by the OSCE. She performed throughout Serbia and abroad. With her Saša Knežević, a pianist, She has made significant performances in Norway, Italy, Slovenia, Croatia, Estonia, the Czech Republic, Macedonia and Germany. She won over audience with her bright voice, crystal clear tone, and attractive appearance.
