Nicolae Gheorghe Square, located in the heart of Bucharest, is dedicated to honoring the legacy of Nicolae Gheorghe. The information below provides an overview of the available space and dimensions within the square for artists submitting proposals for the Nicolae Gheorghe Memorial.

Overall Square Dimensions:

Total Area: 602 square meters

Perimeter: 119 meters

Designated Memorial Space:

A specific area within Nicolae Gheorghe Square has been set aside for the installation of the memorial. Based on spatial calculations, the proposed site for the memorial has the following dimensions:

Maximum Area: 42 square meters

Perimeter of Memorial Space: 20 meters



Guidelines for Memorial Placement:

Artists should consider these dimensions when designing the memorial, ensuring that the structure will integrate smoothly with the square's open setting while maintaining accessibility and encouraging public interaction.

The final location within the square will be discussed with Bucharest City Hall following the selection of the winning proposal.
