Around the world, women are still paid less than men for the same work. For Roma women, the gap is deeper, not only in our paychecks, but in recognition, visibility, and access to opportunity. We also know the path into these industries is not equal. Limited access to funding, exclusion from professional networks, underrepresentation in decision-making, and bias within cultural institutions keep many doors shut. This is shaped by the combined weight of gender inequality, antigypsyism, and exclusion from mainstream cultural and economic spaces. **And yet, we keep creating.** The Cultural and Creative Industries (CCIs) from fashion, music, and film, to literature, crafts, visual arts, and digital media are not just workplaces. WOMNET is part of the **ERIACNET4EU** initiative which focuses on protecting, promoting, and raising awareness of the rights of Roma citizens in the EU, reinforcing EU values such as equality, justice, and non-discrimination.
